Towards the end of this week and start of next week I will be reviewing the sight words with each student that I had assessed from earlier in the school year. Here's a peek at our week:

MATH: Students will be working on doubles with sums to 18, adding 1 to a number, and writing number sentences for subtraction stories.

RELIGION: We will be talking about saying "yes" to God. Reminder, we'll have the Safe and Sacred Training on Thursday.

READING: Our story this week is Citybook. We'll be working on noting details, main ideas, and consonant clusters with l, s.

LANGUAGE ARTS: Students will be working on their phonemic awareness of the medial (middle) consonants in a word.

SPELLING: Our spelling test on Friday will be on the following words from our story: go, long, many, of, on, people, walk
Challenge words: train, shopping, mimes

SOCIAL STUDIES: We will finish, review Unit 2 Where We Live and take a test.

SCIENCE: We will continue our unit on animals and talk about animal groups. Look for information on a science research project this week!
