MATH: We will work on problem solving skills, more and less, the triangle, ordering, and sorting rules.

RELIGION: We will be talking about God's creation and how to be a caretaker of creation. We will review last week and this week and take a test at the end of the week.

READING: Our new story this week is "One Red Rooster." We continue working on initial consonant sounds, predicting, and web charts. We will create our own book on our version of "One Red Rooster."

LANGUAGE ARTS: Students will be working on their phonemic awareness of the consonants h, m, and k.

SPELLING: We will have our first graded spelling test on Friday on the following words from our story: and, cat, dog, fast, one, three, two, went.
Challenge words: rooster, horse, asleep

SOCIAL STUDIES: We will continue talking about families, family rules, and transportation. We'll be working on problem solving skills, and using charts.

SCIENCE: We will review chapter one on our five senses, living, and nonliving things and then take a test on it. We will then move on to chapter two about plants.
