

Second Grade News

November 8th – 12th

Language Arts: This week we will be taking the Theme Test for Be a Nature Detective. This test will be assessing each student on the skills that they have learned these past weeks. We will be having the spelling dictation test on Friday. Please review the spelling patterns with your child.

Phonics: The second graders will begin learning about compound words, one and two syllable words, and words ending in le.

Math: The class will be working with identifying tens and ones and halves, fourths, and eighths fractions. They will also be learning about adding 10 to a multiple of 10 and dividing groups.

Religion: We will continue studying about the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This week we will be focusing on the 10 Commandments. I will be teaching the class about stranger danger on Thursday. We are leading the whole Mass on Wednesday. Every child will have a special job at Mass.

Science: The class will begin Chapter 4: Water Habitats. We will be learning about a habitat in fresh water.

Social Studies: We will be practicing the Thanksgiving Play. Please remember the play will be in our classroom on Wednesday, November 24th at 1:00. Each student will need to wear khaki bottoms and bring a white shirt to school this day (they could wear a white t-shirt under their uniform top).
