CALL TO ORDER/PRAYER: Tanya Weinzierl called the meeting to order and led the group in an opening prayer.

FUNDRAISING UP-DATE:

- **New fundraising budget for 2007-2008.** The first Fundraising Committee meeting for this school year will be held the end of August. The committee's goal this year will be to raise \$80,000. Look for a packet of information about volunteering for this committee in September.
- Last year, the committee raised \$75,500. Chad Denucci will give more details about amounts raised at the September H&S meeting.
- New for this year. There will be no Football Mania tickets sold this fall. Tanya said she would like more feedback before a decision is made about which Mania tickets we will sell. There is a correction on the St. Mary's School Schedule sheet. There will not be a Home & School Breakfast on September 23rd. So please make that correction to the school year schedule. We will only have one Home & School Breakfast scheduled for Catholic School's Week in January 2008.

TECHNOLOGY UPDATE: Mari commended Tammy Goss, Anne Getschel, Kevin Effertz, Geoff Davis, and Joe Eral for all of the hard work and long hours that they have put into maintenance of the school's computer network. There is a little work to finish, but she assured the group that everything will be completed by the first day of school. Thank you so much, you have saved the school thousands of dollars!

PRE-K UP-DATE: Mari informed the group that the Pre-K program which consists of 3 sessions, 12 students per class, is full. She also noted that St. Mary's was one of the first sights to fill up. The pre-school has 9 children enrolled.

OLD BUSINESS/OPEN DISCUSSION: Open House for the new school year will be August 17, 2007 from 12:30-1:30. Enrollment for this year consists of 173 students, 127 are in grades K-8.

There was no further business to discuss. The meeting adjourned at 7:10p.m with a motion made by Joan Simpson and seconded by Sally Hopkins. Mari led the group in a final prayer.
